Applicants must be a high school graduate or GED recipient. They must have served in the Army National Guard for a minimum of one year and be in good standing with the Guard.

Additionally, Grantham University offers military scholarships for active duty, reserve, guard, veterans and military family members as well as scholarships for law enforcement personnel. Grantham’s Military Scholarship covers the cost of required books, software and the tuition remaining after Military Tuition Assistance benefits have been applied.
